ORDINANCE FOR SLOW-NO-WAKE DURING HIGH WATER PERIODS

A SOLE ORDINANCE TO REGULATE BOATING UPON THE WATERS OF LAKE SINISSIPPI AND THE UPPER REACH OF THE ROCK RIVER AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The Board of Commissioners of Lake Sinissippi Improvement District of Dodge County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section I Applicability and Enforcement

- A. The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of Lake Sinissippi and the upper reach of the Rock River within the jurisdiction of the Townships of Hubbard and Oak Grove.
- B. This Ordinance shall be enforced by officers of the Townships of Hubbard, Hustisford and Oak Grove, the Village of Hustisford and the Dodge County Sheriff's Department.

Section II Intent

The intent of this Ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests and the capability of the water resources.

Section III State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in ss. 30.50 to 30.71 and s. 30.77, Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section IV **Definitions**

"Hazardous conditions" mean those conditions that may exist on lake and river as a result of high water that threaten public safety and property damage. Such conditions may include the presence of floating cattail bogs, trees and other debris that pose a threat to safe boating and that may damage shoreline structures and affect safe operation of the Hustisford Dam.

"Slow-no-wake" means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.

Section V Controlled Area and Period

No person shall operate a boat faster than slow-no-wake in the waters of Lake Sinissippi and the upper reach of the Rock River when the water level is at or exceeds elevation 100.00 as based on the measuring strip gauge located at the upstream end of the east concrete abutment of the Hustisford Dam (14.4 inches of water above spillway crest of dam).

This slow-no-wake restriction will be posted at all public access points when in effect.

This slow-no-wake restriction will be removed when the water level is below elevation 99.90 (13.2 inches of water above spillway crest of dam) for a period of three consecutive days, unless hazardous conditions exist. Following cessation of hazardous conditions, the slow-no-wake restriction will be removed

Section VI **Posting Requirements**

The Lake Sinissippi Improvement District shall place and maintain a synopsis of this Ordinance at all public access points pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15 Wis. Admin. Code.

Section VII Penalties

Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in s. 30.80, Wis. Stats., and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

Section VIII Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Board of Commissioners would have passed the other provisions of this Ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

Section IX Effective Date

The section will become effective upon passage and the day after publication.

No person shall operate a boat faster than slowno-wake in the waters of Lake Sinissippi and the upper reach of the Rock River when the water level is at or exceeds elevation 100.00 at the Hustisford Dam (14.4 inches of water over the spillway).

LOCAL ORDINANCE SLOW-NO-WAKE IN HABITAT PROTECTION ZONES

No person shall operate a boat faster than slowno-wake in habitat protection zones of Lake Sinissippi as marked by safety buoys and shown as no-wake zones on the accompanying lake map.
